Position Purpose:

To further the mission and vision of Lake Logan by providing a safe, fun, and attractive environment at the waterfront for children, youth, and adults to gather for recreation and retreat.

Responsibilities:

- Serve as host to waterfront guests – providing on-site presence on weekends, checking in guests, enforcing rules, and keeping the area clean.
- Communicate with season members in person and via telephone / email.
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications, Skills, and Abilities Required:

- Ages 16 and up.
- Desire to work in a faith-based setting.
- Ability to work on a team, relate, and work well with others.
- Ability to work independently after receiving initial direction.
- Ability to be pleasantly assertive and deal with conflict.
- Ability to receive guidance, direction, and supervision.
- Visual and auditory ability to identify and respond to environmental and other hazards related to the center operation.
- Physical ability to respond appropriately to situations requiring first aid (minor first aid, call 911, etc).
- Ability to assist guests in an emergency (fire, evacuation, illness, or injury).

Schedule:

- Position(s) available May through August. Starting and ending dates are negotiable.
- 16-24 hours per week, 9 AM to 5 PM, Friday through Sunday plus Memorial Day.
- This position can be combined with the Lawncare Assistant position to create a full-time seasonal position.

Salary and Benefits

- \$10 per hour, paid bi-weekly.
- Occasional meals
- Use of Lake Logan's recreation equipment and facilities during off hours when it does not interfere with guest / camper use.
